IMPORTANT INFO

Candidates for Confirmation:

- MUST be baptized Catholics or baptized Christians of other denominations
 who have made a Profession of Faith in the Catholic Church. Those who are
 not yet baptized will be invited to join the RCIA [Rite of Christian Initiation for
 Adults].
- MUST be of 8th grade age or older.
- MUST have at least two years of recent religious formation & instruction (in a Catholic school, parish Religious Education / Faith Formation, or Home Study Program).
- Should realize that the decision to celebrate this Sacrament is your individual free-will choice.

BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE

If you were **NOT** baptized at St. John the Evangelist or St. Joseph Parish, we will need a RECENT copy of your Baptismal Certificate from the parish where you were Baptized. **Please provide your parish of Baptism information so that we can request that information.** If you have any questions on sacramental records or do not know what parish you were Baptized in, please contact Angel Koerkel at the parish office.

CONFIRMATION NAME

It is traditional that you choose a Saint or a Venerable (someone "on the road to sainthood" who may not yet have been canonized) to be your patron, your role model, your companion on the journey. Carefully, prayerfully choose this Saint and make sure to pray for his or her intercession as you prepare for Confirmation. You may choose a name that is of a Saint who is not your gender (females may choose male Saints and vice versa).

You MAY keep your baptismal name (your REAL, legal name) if you choose. Your Confirmation Name may also be a Christian virtue (for example: Faith, Joy, Charity).







SERVICE

YOU MUST DEMONSTRATE CHRISTIAN LOVE THROUGH SERVING OTHERS!

We want you to keep a very brief log of service: ways you have HELPED OTHER PEOPLE. It should include AT LEAST one entry a month and should have some things listed that help your family, your Parish, your community, and the wider world! Ask your sponsor to serve with you! It will give you both a chance to talk about what it means to live out a Christian life! *A minimum of 15 hrs.* over the course of the year in a variety of areas is expected.

Suggestions—but not limited to—for Service:

Teacher Aid for Sunday Religious Education • Help stock shelves and organize at the St. Vincent DePaul Store • Teacher Aid for the summer Vacation Bible School • Helping an elderly neighbor with shopping • Lawn work • Baby-sitting • Cooking and serving at any of the great food festivals • Helping with the area Special Religious Education • Making a meal for an ill or elderly friend • Visiting nursing homes • Jackson Interfaith Shelter • Local food pantries • Sending supplies to troops overseas • Tutoring a younger student • Altar Serving • Help at Birthline, Center for Women, St. Vincent DePaul, American Cancer Society, Habitat for Humanity, AWARE Shelter, Disability Connections, Special Olympics, Humane Society, Animal Shelter, the Red Cross or other agencies

Interview

Each candidate will be required to meet one-on-one with a member of the Pastoral Staff or other designated interviewers. This is not a test or a win/lose determination... it is a chance to chat, ask questions, and make a personal connection! Interviews will not be long, a half hour or so and will be scheduled in the summer of 2018, after candidates have finished their 40 Questions & Letter to the Bishop. If you have completed those items and would like to schedule your interview sooner than next summer, please contact Clare Kolenda to set up an appointment.

Interviewers may include our priests, pastoral staff, Youth Ministry team and the Confirmation team. Typically you will be allowed to choose the person you are most comfortable with!

It will be YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to finish YOUR 40 Questions & Letter to the Bishop by the March 3rd Retreat...

Your Letter Requesting Confirmation

You are free to respond to God's call to live your life with Him: to worship, serve, learn and join in community. If you wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, Bishop Boyea asks that YOU START THE PROCESS by writing a letter to the him requesting the Sacrament.

Your letter should be written to Bishop Earl Boyea, but sent to the parish offices (address to: Angel Koerkel, St. John Parish, 711 N. Francis St., 49201). We send the letters to the Bishop all at once as a packet.

Please follow this format or similar:

Most Reverend Earl Boyea Bishop of the Diocese of Lansing

Greeting

"Dear Bishop Boyea," or more formally "Most Reverend Earl Boyea, Bishop of the Diocese of Lansing"

Body of the letter (these are SUGGESTIONS... feel free to be creative!)

Paragraph 1: Introduce yourself. Tell him things like where you are from, which church you attend, what school, or something about your family or your background.

Paragraph 2: Request the Sacrament. Write something like: "I would like to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation..." or "I am ready to confirm my Baptism..." Give a couple of reasons WHY you are asking to confirm your Baptism.

Paragraph 3: Explain how you plan to prepare for the Sacrament: service, religious education, Mass attendance, involvement with the parish, etc.

Paragraph 4: Tell him how you plan to make your confirmation in the Faith real and alive. How will you continue to be a strong Catholic Christian?

Conclusion

Make sure to sign your letter after the appropriate closing. Say something like "I am looking forward to the day of Confirmation" or "Thank you for your love and service to our Diocese" or some other appropriate line.

Close with "Best regards" or "With great respect" or "In Christ" or "Asking Your Excellency's blessing, I am, Yours respectfully..."

WEEKLY MASS ATTENDANCE

If Mass is not a priority for you, it won't be for your children

SACRAMENTAL CONFESSION

Required of all Catholics at least once a year We recommend going with your child the week before Confirmation Mass

LIVING THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF CATHOLICISM

Full description can be found in the Catechism (#2041-3) See summary below

The Precepts of the Church, the **MINIMUM** expectations of all Catholics according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church #2041-3, are to:

- 1) attend Mass on Sundays & holy days of obligation
- 2) observe days of fasting and abstinence as established by the Church
- 3) sacramentally confess your sins at least once a year
- 4) receive the Eucharist at least during the Easter season
- 5) help provide for the needs of the Church

Sponsor Preparation

Sponsors do NOT play a symbolic role for the candidate. **Sponsors MUST be** active, participating Catholic Christians with a desire to share their lived faith.

The sponsors and the candidates should be in regular contact during the preparation period, including time spent together at Mass, serving others, working on the 40 Questions, and experiencing Parish opportunities together. Parents may not be sponsors according to Canon Law (874).

What we, and the Church, expect from you, as sponsor:

Pray for your candidate throughout this year and long past the day of Confirmation

Attend Mass every Sunday & holy day - make sure that your candidate is also attending Sunday Mass!

Frequent the sacrament of **Reconciliation** this year and go with your candidate the week before celebrating their Confirmation

Look over the opportunities in this packet and **encourage** your candidate to get more involved in parish life!

Your role as Sponsor **does not end** the day Bishop Boyea anoints the candidate; you are companions on this journey for the rest of your lives! Several Sponsors have shared with us how moved and inspired they have been walking through this preparation and the actual day of Confirmation... please EXPECT God to do something with YOU during this time!

We do have a short Sponsor FORM for you to fill out and have signed by your pastor. Please make sure that is returned to our office by January 1, 2018.


From the Code of Canon Law - CONFIRMATION SPONSORS:

872 A sponsor... helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it.

873 There is to be only one male sponsor or one female sponsor...

874 To be permitted to take on the function of sponsor a person must:

- have completed the sixteenth year of age, unless the diocesan bishop has established another age...;
- be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on:
- not be the father or mother


