ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Our Religious Education is directly connected to the Sunday Mass and is for the whole family. There are three main guiding principles that are leading us:

1) SUNDAY MASS IS THE CLASS, JESUS THE TEACHER. As the source and summit of the Christian life (Catechism of the Catholic Church, Paragraph 1324), everything should point toward and flow out of the Eucharist; that is where Jesus himself teaches and feeds us. Family Discipleship class provides an extension for what Jesus gives us in the Sacred Liturgy.

2) PARENTS ARE THE PRIMARY EDUCATORS OF THEIR CHILDREN, our role at the parish is to help parents live out the promise they made at their child's Baptism to raise them in the Catholic faith. We are here to assist you, the real teachers of your children. (CCC 2223)

3) SACRAMENTS MUST BE PRECEDED BY EVANGELIZING, FAITH, AND CONVERSION! (CCC 1072) When someone receives First Holy Eucharist, Confirmation, or ANY of the Sacraments, we want to know they have fallen in love with Jesus and his beautiful Church! We do not mechanically push people through a conveyor belt system like a manufactured product.

We meet most Sundays of the year in the parish community center, 11:15-11:45am. In addition, your family attends either the 10am or 12pm Mass together where children (potty-trained thru 5th grade) are invited to dismiss to the Children's Liturgy of the Word for an age appropriate discussion of the Gospel and prayer. Mass attendance is the core of our religious education and it is expected that families registering a child are attending Sunday Mass together.
